

Clyde Windsurfing Club

Club Rules

1. Please ensure you have read and understood this document.
2. All members must adhere to the club constitution. A copy can be obtained from the secretary or other committee member.
3. Only use the designated club equipment. Some of the windsurfing equipment in the compound belongs to others.
4. Only club members who have been inducted can use club equipment.
5. Under no circumstances allow any non members use of club equipment.
6. The member must be at least level 1 standard but if the member has not participated in a level 1 course confirmation by an authorised CWC instructor is satisfactory. The standard expected is to sail a triangular course, be able to self rescue, launching and landing. Know the local rights of way and zones for Castle Semple loch.
7. The members must show due consideration to other water users and wildlife.
8. Club equipment shall be treated with respect to prolong the lifetime for other water users.
9. All breakages or damage shall be reported to Mike McIntosh (contact details below). We do not currently charge for damage to club equipment but we do not want other members to use unsafe or damaged equipment.
10. It is up to the member to confirm any Castle Semple Loch rescue boat arrangements. The club does not provide rescue cover except for organised courses.
11. All equipment will be returned to the compound in a tidy manner.
12. The club do not provide third party liability cover for members using their own or club equipment except during organised instruction courses. The activity is completely at ones own risk. The RYA or other insurers such as Sailsafe provide this facility at a reasonable cost.
13. The club and committee accept no liability for any injury or loss sustained while carrying or using the equipment.
14. If there is an injury or accident to a third party please report it to the the principal immediately.
15. Club equipment must not be used if the wind is greater than Force 3.
16. All club equipment is reserved for the youth and T15 sections on a Wednesday evening May to September. There may be other times that the club will reserve use of the equipment. Where possible this information will be posted on the club website Forum under club news.
17. Do not use the equipment under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
